Message: Hope: Riches of Our Glorious Inheritance

Text: Ephesians 1:16-18

"16I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, 17that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, 18having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints..." Ephesians 1:16-18

THANKSGIVING/GRATITUDE is based upon the faithfulness and mercies of God in the past; while HOPE is looking towards the future with confidence and joy because of the Abba goodness of the Father, secured by the cross and resurrection of the Son, and applied to our hearts by the Holy Spirit.

"The apostle Paul is praying that the eyes of our understanding may be enlightened in order that we may come to know the character of the inheritance to which we are going, the inheritance which God is preparing for us....The Apostle, is praying that we may come to see more and more of what lies ahead for us, and that we may have more frequent glimpses of it. He does not wish it to be something remote and strange to us. His desire is that we may not only look (2:20) at our title deeds and specifications, but that by faith we may have an occasional glimpse of the inheritance itself..." Martin Lloyd-Iones, God's Ultimate Purpose, p. 379

"What is sanctification....As the Holy Spirit applies the death and resurrection of Christ to his people, he renews them in their whole being to become in whole being after the image of God; having the seeds of, showing a life of repentance, and all other saving graces, put into their hearts, and those graces so stirred up, increased and strengthened, so that they MORE AND MORE die unto sin and rise unto newness of life." Larger Catechism, Ouestion 75

"This sanctification is throughout the whole man, yet it is imperfect in this life because there abides within us some remnants of corruption in every part; from which arises a continual and irreconcilable war, the flesh lusts against the Spirit and the Spirit against the flesh."

Westminster Confession of Faith, Article 13, Sanctification, Part Two.

3. The pondering of eternity leads to obedient living and a deep desire to continually taste the goodness of the Lord by living a life of holiness.
