Speaker: Pastor Buster Brown Message: Invigorating Living Scripture: Ecclesiastes 12:9-14

9 Besides being wise, the Preacher also taught the people knowledge, weighing and studying and arranging many proverbs with great care. 10 The Preacher sought to find words of delight, and uprightly he wrote words of truth. 11 The words of the wise are like goads, and like nails firmly fixed are the collected sayings; they are given by one Shepherd. 12 My son, beware of anything beyond these. Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh. 13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. 14 For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil. Solomon is "coming home" from a prolonged season of abandoning the one, true God (Jeremiah 2:13) and embracing an "Under the Sun (only)" lifestyle.

Under the Sun (only)

### Epicureanism:

Ecclesiastes 12:9-14

"god" is undefinable...

The pursuit of pleasure and avoidance of pain in a socially acceptable fashion. The ultimate reality of God is undefinable (because of mulitple 'gods'); therefore His presence is not joyfully binding..

Under the Sun (only) living does not embrace ultimate truth and therefore provides no foundation for sustainable in the long run.

- Observant living (Ecclesiastes 12:9-10)
- The joy of having the Good Shepherd (Ecclesiastes 12:11)

"goads" The joy/wonder of the goad or staff is a result of the one who wields it.

- "nails firmly fixed"
- The pursuit of true wisdom (wisdom vs. knowledge)

"(Scripture) reveals the principles by which God judges us, and therefore is, and will remain, to the end of the world, the true center of Christian union, and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds and religious opinions should be tried. All scripture is a testimony to Christ who is Himself the focus of Divine revelation."

- digest and ponder) 3 to 4 verses in the passage.
- Communicate your plan to a member of your community team.
- 7. Make weekly application. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)


#### **CHRISTMAS CHALLENGE**


