"Now King Solomon loved many foreign women, along with the daughter of Pharaoh: Moabite, Ammonite, Edomite, Sidonian, and Hittite women, from the nations concerning which the Lord had said to the people of Israel, You shall not enter into marriage with them, neither shall they with you, for surely they will turn away your heart after their gods.' Solomon clung to these in love. He had 700 wives, who were princesses, and 300 concubines. And his wives turned away his heart. The pursuit of pleasure and avoidance of pain in a socially acceptable fashion. The ultimate reality of God is undefinable (because of mulitple 'gods'); therefore His presence is not joyfully binding..

Under The Sun only Worldview

If there are many 'gods' then there is no ultimate definition of God.

- Embrace a 'god' that will meet my perceived needs (selecting from a multiplicity of choices). See John 6:66-69.
- There is no ultimate truth because multiple 'gods' have spoken.

Biblical Worldview

- "There is one and only one living and true God. He is an intelligent, spiritual, and personal Being, the Creator, Redeemer, Preserver, and Ruler of the universe." Baptist Faith & Message
- God eternally exists, and the glorification/ worship of God and human flourishing are inexplicably intertwined.




