Message: Praise for God's Ways

Text: Psalm 33

Big Idea: God's sovereign and lovely ways inspire His people's trust and praise.

1. Praise is Fitting (vv. 1-3)

"Shout for joy in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the upright." Psalm 33:1

- This praise is loud (vv. 1 & 3) and skillful (vv. 2-3).
- Our singing is revealing.
- 2. ...Because God's Sovereignty is Lovely (vv. 4-19)

His Sovereign and Lovely Word (vv. 4-9) "For the word of the Lord is upright, and all his work is done in faithfulness." Psalm 33:4

His Sovereign and Lovely Plans (vv. 10-12) "The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of his heart to all generations. Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people whom he has chosen as his heritage!" Psalm 33:11

<u>His Sovereign and Lovely Sight</u> (vv. 13-19) "Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear him, on those who hope in his steadfast love, that he may deliver their soul from death and keep them alive in famine." Psalm 33:18

3. ...So Trust is Possible (vv. 20-22)

"Our soul waits for the Lord, He is our help and shield." Psalm 33:20

But life in its ordinary course also can sometimes raise doubts in the mind about the providence of God. Is not mystery the portion of mankind?
