"¹⁰For a day in your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness. ¹¹For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord bestows favor and honor. No good thing does he withhold from those who walk uprightly. ¹²O Lord of hosts, blessed is the one who trusts in you!" **Psalm 84:10-12**

"The Christian faith is a doctrine not of the tongue but of life. From the constitution of our nature, the former method is altogether incompetent and ineffectual, and the latter method will alone suffice for the rescue and recovery of the heart from the wrong affection that domineers over it." **Thomas Chalmers**, The Expulsive Power of a New Affection


- 1. "Anyone who waits for happiness will never be happy. If we realize we are undeserving, suddenly the world comes alive. Instead of whining about everything that goes wrong, we are surprised at God's many kindnesses and our hearts overflow with thanksgiving." Randy Alcorn, Happiness
- 2. The happiest people in the world are those who have a deep, gratitude-drenched relationship with Christ (versus the entitled perspective of saying "I deserve this" and "I deserve more.")
