Gifts: A gift says, "He was thinking about me. Look what he got for me."

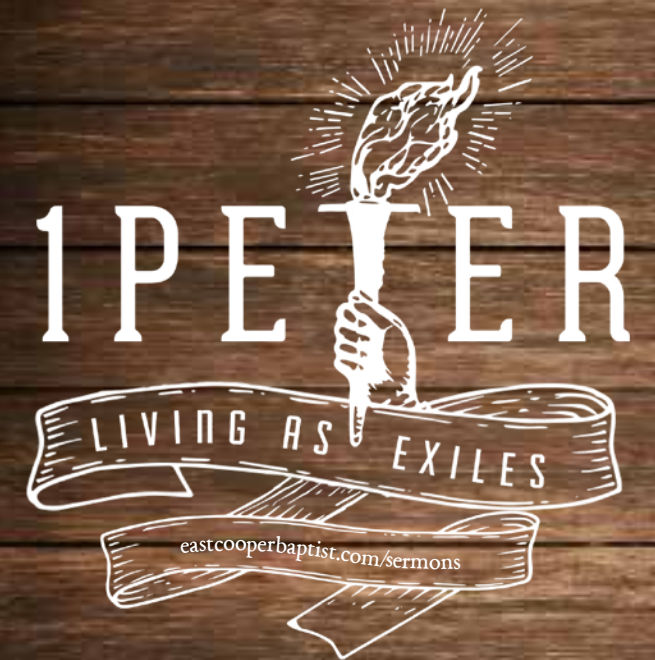
